Item	Description
1.	Ditch maintenance – flooding Use of Lengths man
2.	Road surfaces – improved – large potholes need repair strategy
3.	Better IT – 2 exchanges (Skenfrith is worst) need to consider microwave
4.	Verge cutting/wildflowers/tractors too big. Inappropriate machinery for size of lanes
5.	Mobile phone coverage poor
6.	Telephone boxes 2 operational one card only
7.	Speed limits in Turning and other areas of narrow roads. Protection of cyclists and walkers
8.	Affordable housing for local people
9.	Building in parents land for Children and elderly parents – make it easier
10.	New village Hall – Where?
11.	Want to keep – Village Pub, Post Office, Shop
12.	Ambulance response times
13.	First Responders to be identified through Parish Plan (working with Ambulance service)
14.	Easily affordable Solar Panels
15.	School and Playgroup needs support and new pupils to survive
16.	Bus Services – mini buses to town
17.	Community woodland planted and owned by community
18.	Community vegetable and fruit plots owned and managed by community
19.	Financial help/advice for road safety measures particularly and junctions
20.	Responsibility for fences alongside verges – identify responsibilities Council or Landowners
21.	Common land valued
22.	Hedges valued CPRE removal by Council and road safety
23.	Council owned culverts under roads not to be threatened with closure. Need to be maintained to prevent flooding
24.	Annual survey of garden hedges for road safety particularly large carriers/lorries
25.	Protect open spaces for public benefit
26.	New building linked to environmental concerns
27.	Wind turbines ( subject to public discussion and debate)
28.	Alternative energy sources to be considered
29.	Better policing – follow ups required after reporting of crimes. PC does attend Parish Council meetings
30.	Small scale road improvements e.g. widening or more passing places.
